Project Update – New Pavilion

The committee is pleased to announce that the New Pavilion Project is now fully funded and construction should commence by the end of March 2015. During construction, car parking spaces off Station Road will be very limited. A full Traffic Management Plan is available to read in the Parish Office.

Preparatory work has already been completed with soil samples and relocation of the two storage containers on the playing field. These containers have been clad in wood and are coated in an anti graffiti paint so will be in keeping with the new building.

Before the Parish Council's old storage unit is removed, a new machinery store will be erected this month in the previously agreed location at White's Field, alongside the Windmill.

Chinnor Neighbourhood Plan

The Council has now set the boundary of a designated area for a Neighbourhood Plan.

The boundary is for the entire Parish:

Chinnor, Henton, Wainhill, Emmington and Chinnor Hill.

Project Update – Fitness Equipment



We are pleased to confirm that £5,148.00 has been awarded to the village by The National Lottery towards the cost of outdoor fitness equipment.

Following our public consultation, an order has been placed for four pieces of equipment to be installed on the Playing Fields in an area near the Lower Road pedestrian entrance. Look out for our formal opening announcement.

Job Vacancy

At present Chinnor Youth Club at White's Field in Mill Lane, is open on Thursday evenings. Due to the success of the club and demand for expansion, the village needs an additional Youth Leader.

This will be a paid position at £10 per hour. Applicants must be over 18 years of age.

Supported by our established Youth Leader and a team of volunteers, our new recruit would run one other evening initially.

However, this role could be developed in future to include a separate "drop-in" session for young people.
