LOCAL BUS SERVICE UPDATE

Following the news earlier in the year that OCC have
withdrawn all subsidies to bus providers; Chinnor
Parish Council are pleased to announce that two of
the service providers have confirmed the routes will
continue as a commercial service.

Red Rose Travel – 275 - Oxford to High Wycombe -
This service will continue.

Carousel Bus – 40 - High Wycombe to Thame - This
service will continue.

Thames Travel – T1 – Oxford via Watlington service –
new service begun in July

Redline – Chiltern Railway – 320 – Bus service to Princes Risborough Railway
We regret to inform you the service 120, 121 to Princes Risborough is no longer
running.

All timetables are available to collect from the information area in the
Community Pavilion foyer.

As these services are all now commercial routes please use the bus as much as
